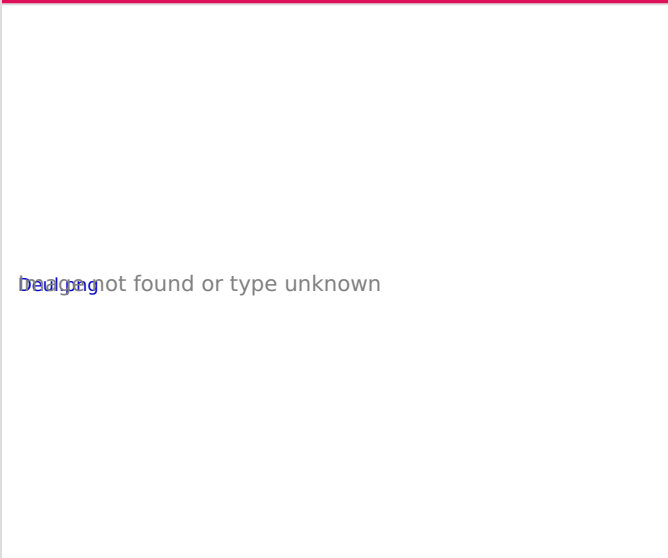

(Has whip made out of plants- can be used to attack and capture opponent)

+Does not need basic human needs

(food, air, rest, etc.)

+No bones but physically resistant

(Flexible, light but sturdy)

<Kamua Dagda (Minor Branch)>

The Kamua Dagda have very strong legs and arms, and have traditionally been very skilled at combat.

Combined with his training sessions he has taken seriously from a young age, Deul is a fairly skilled physical fighter.

+Stronger muscles than average

(Can deliver a very strong punch or kick, high endurance and stamina, can move fairly fast)

Strengths

+A lot of training

(Less stunned by attacks and physical pain, knows what most weapons do, and does not care if he gets hurt if he can land a blow)

+Skilled fighter

(Has learnt to fight without relying on powers - skilled physical fighter)

Weaknesses

<Dragon' Blood>

-Diluted powers

(Must be touching the plant (directly or indirectly (through other plant)) to control it, cannot grow plants (can forcibly stretch them but it makes them weaker))

-Extension of mind

(Plants moves how he imagines them - Trying to move too much at once can get confusing and stops movement)

-Still mortal.

(Can be killed with enough damage)

-Dehydration

(Lack of water will weaken him significantly)

<Kamua Dagda (Minor Branch)>

-Easily dehydrated from extreme exercises

(Extreme exercise would be using his muscles for things above an average human (ex. Making a hole in the wall, kicking people across the room, etc.))

-Weakened by lack of light

(Cannot manipulate plants in completely dark area)

<Other>


+Instinctive


(Moves by instinct- Things he was not expecting or does not know will slow him down, and cannot follow most plans (nor make good ones). Tends to just go to tackle the opponent, even when there is a conveniently placed tree in front of him.)

-Shines

(Easy to spot in a dark place)

-Extra notes on name: The children of the Rlakda family inherit the name of one of their predecessors after they reach adulthood. Therefore, their first name is more of a title, though it is used at official meetings and in daily life. Their middle/second name is their 'true' name that was given to them when they were born, and used by friends and those close to them.

Deul will introduce himself with his first name to most people, but understand it is hard to pronounce to many, so he uses 'Deul' as a nickname (a little reluctantly since he thinks nicknames sound 'unofficial'). However, he seldom gives out his full, middle name and will often not answer if it comes from a stranger.
